**1. The Day of the Bible:** Designates September 12, 2025, as "The Day of the Bible" in Pennsylvania. ✓

**2. Regulatory Review and Accountability:** Requires all state regulations costing over \$1 million annually to be formally reviewed after three years. ✓

**3. Forced Student Loan Application:** Would require all high-school seniors in Pennsylvania to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). ✗

**4. Fairness in Women's Sports Act:** Requires Pennsylvania school and college sports teams to be designated by biological sex at birth, barring males from female teams and protecting schools that enforce sex-based divisions. ✓

**5. Noncitizens in Agriculture and Licensure:** Updates poultry technician licensing by expanding eligibility to all legal U.S. residents, raising fees, granting the state agriculture secretary broader power, and strengthening enforcement. ✗

Constitutional: **No** · Cast: **Yes** · HB324 · 02/05/2025

**6. CO2 Trading Program Repeal:** Ends Pennsylvania's participation in RGGI by repealing CO<sub>2</sub> trading regulations and requiring legislative approval for any future emissions-related programs or taxes. ✓
