1. No Wages by Cash or Check: Would permit employers to eliminate wages by cash or check. ✗

2. Carbon Capture and Sequestration Act: Authorizes carbon sequestration projects to reduce "greenhouse gas emissions" and empowers the state Department of Environmental Protection to designate "environmental justice" areas based on "demographic, economic, health and environmental data." ✓

3. Federal Drug Pricing: Requires pharmacy benefit managers to comply with the federal 340B Drug Pricing Program. ✗

Constitutional: **No** · Cast: **Yes** · HB1993 · 07/10/2024

4. Funding State-Aided Universities: Provides funding for several state-related universities (Penn State, Pitt, Temple, and Lincoln) and a private Ivy League university (Penn). ✓

Estimated Cost per household: **-\$123.00/year.**

5. Parental Consent for Mental Health Services: Would require parental consent to virtual mental health services provided by or in coordination with a school entity. ✓

Constitutional: **Yes** · Cast: **Yes** · SB913 · 06/27/2024

6. States' Powers to Combat Illegal Migration: Urges the Governor to offer the services of the Pennsylvania National Guard to the State of Texas in support of Operation Lone Star. ✓
