1. "Open Primary" Elections: Would let registered voters with no political party affiliation vote in primary elections.



Constitutional: **No** · Cast: **No** · HB976 · 10/21/2024

2. Funding State-Aided Universities: Provides funding for several state-related universities (Penn State, Pitt, Temple, and Lincoln) and a private Ivy League university (Penn).



Estimated Cost per household: **-\$123.00/year.**

Constitutional: **No** · Cast: **Yes** · HB613 · 07/11/2024

3. Carbon Capture and Sequestration Act: Authorizes carbon sequestration projects to reduce "greenhouse gas emissions" and empowers the state Department of Environmental Protection to designate "environmental justice" areas based on "demographic, economic, health and environmental data."



Constitutional: **No** · Cast: **Yes** · SB831 · 07/11/2024

4. Driver's Licenses for Illegal Aliens: Would allow a person who is 16 or 17 years of age and meets the definition of "homeless children and youths" under federal law to use a temporary address, along with the signature of a "teacher," "social worker," or "caseworker," when applying for a driver's license or identification card.

5. "Morning-After" Pill Mandate: Would require health benefit plans to cover all FDA-approved contraceptive drugs and adult male or adult female sterilization surgery.

6. Ban on "Ghost Guns": Would amend the Uniform Firearms Act to prohibit the purchase, sale, and production of firearm or firearm parts without serial numbers. ✓
