3. Inflation Reduction Act: Spends at least \$512 billion on multiple unconstitutional and left-wing programs and initiatives. ✓ Estimated Cost per household: **-\$4,014.00/year.**

4. Hydrofluorocarbons Reduction: Ratifies the Kigali Amendment to the 1987 Montreal Protocol, requiring the U.S. to increase regulations. ✗

5. Marriage: Repeals the Defense of Marriage Act and codifies the "right" to marry regardless of sexual orientation. ✗

6. Omnibus 2023 Spending: Spends \$1.7 trillion on multiple unconstitutional programs and agencies. — Estimated Cost per household: **-\$13,328.00/year.**
