1. Airport Grants: Appropriates \$10,000,000 from the general fund to the Aeronautics Commission for grants aimed at enhancing airport terminal infrastructure projects, including airport expansion. **✗**
Estimated Cost per household: **-\$28.00/year.**

2. Reject Eminent Domain: Prohibits companies from using eminent domain to construct pipelines primarily for transporting carbon oxide for geological storage or sequestration. **✗**

3. Prohibit Drag Shows on Campus: Prohibits the Board of Regents or any institution under its control from using state resources for drag shows or other "obscene live conduct" on college campuses. **✓**

Constitutional: **Yes** · Cast: **Yes** · HB1178 · 02/29/2024

4. Prohibit Guaranteed Income Programs: Prohibits counties, townships, and municipalities in South Dakota from establishing ordinances, orders, or rules that implement a guaranteed income program. **✓**

Constitutional: **Yes** · Cast: **Yes** · SB115 · 02/26/2024

5. Pipeline Easements: Forces landowners to grant a right-of-way for carbon dioxide pipelines, putting their property at risk, disguising it as "property rights." **✗**

Constitutional: **No** · Cast: **Yes** · HB1186 · 03/06/2024

6. Carbon-Capture Pipeline: Facilitates the construction of carbon-capture pipelines that threaten property rights, permits state authorities to override local ordinances regulating the pipelines for safety or economic reasons, and fails to impose restrictions on eminent domain.
