VA Legislative Scorecard 2025

1. Allows all local governments in Virginia to adopt ranked-choice voting (RCV) for their elections, including positions such as mayor and school-board members. **✗**

2. Proposed establishing the Virginia Center for Firearm Violence Intervention and Prevention within the Department of Criminal Justice Services. **✗**

Estimated cost per household: **-\$1.13/year.**

3. Creates the Virginia Sports Tourism Grant Program, administered by the Virginia Tourism Authority. **✗**

Estimated cost per household: **-\$2.41/year.**

4. Restrict the deployment of the Virginia National Guard into active combat situations unless Congress has officially declared war. **✓**

Constitutional: **Yes** · Cast: **Yes** · HB2193 · 02/04/2025

5. Aimed to mandate that health-insurance plans covering outpatient prescription drugs also provide coverage for FDA-approved contraceptive drugs and devices, including over-the-counter options. **✗**

Estimated cost per household: **-\$0.75/year.**

Constitutional: **No** · Cast: **Yes** · HB2371 · 02/04/2025

6. Proposed the creation of the Solar Interconnection Grant Program to provide competitive grants to public bodies, such as local governments and school boards, to help offset the costs of connecting solar-energy facilities to the electric grid. **✗**

Estimated cost per household: **-\$0.05/year.**

Constitutional: **No** · Cast: **Yes** · HB2113 · 02/04/2025
