1. Would repeal the Affordable Heat Act in its entirety, including eliminating of the Clean Heat Standard.

2. Creates the Vermont Age-Appropriate Design Code Act, which imposes extensive regulations on "covered businesses," mandating highest-level default privacy settings for minors, as well as restrictions on data collection, processing, sharing, and retention of minors' personal data.

3. Declares Vermont's support for the "Transgender and non-binary community" and commitment to the LGBTQ+ movement.
