1. Amtrack Reauthorization: Authorizes \$7.2 billion for Amtrak funding over the next four years. **✗**

2. Trade Promotion Authority: The House held separate roll call votes on the Trade Promotion Authority (TPA) and Trade Adjustment Assistance (TAA) sections of H.R. 1314. **✓**

3. Environmental Executive Orders: Prohibits the use of funds for President Obama's executive orders that require the Defense Department to meet "green" energy mandates. **✗**

4. Warrantless Surveillance: Bars the use of funds in the bill from being used to conduct warrantless searches of Americans' digital communications that have crossed the U.S. border. **✓**

5. Aid to Syria: Prohibits the use of funds in the bill for the Syria Train and Equip Program. **✓**

6. Continuing Appropriations: Provides funding for federal government operations at the fiscal year 2016 level through April 28, 2017 at an annualized "discretionary" rate of \$1.07 trillion. **✓**
