1. Would have repealed Governor Tony Evers' 2023 "partial veto" that provides an annual \$325 per-pupil adjustment in the school-district revenue formula until 2425.

Estimated benefit per household: **+\$98.96/year.**

2. Expands Medicaid to offer up to 12 months of postpartum coverage.

3. Would appropriate \$60 million in annual funding toward contributions to Trump Accounts during the 2025-27 fiscal biennium.

4. Would have prohibited a city, village, town, or county from enacting a "rights of nature ordinance."
