1. **SB43 Women's History Month** (Passed 33 to 2 on 3/28/2025). Formally establishes March as Women's History Month in Alaska statute. **YES**

2. **HB69 Government-school Funding** (Passed 21 to 16 on 4/11/2025). increases the state's base student allocation for public schools by an inflation-based amount tied to the Alaska consumer price index, plus an additional \$1,000. **YES**

Estimated cost per household: **-\$1,017.00/year.**

3. **HB26 Government Transportation** (Passed 22 to 17 on 5/2/2025). Requires the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) to develop and maintain a statewide public and community transit plan. **YES**

4. **HJR11 Canada Partnership Resolution** (Passed 34 to 6 on 5/7/2025). Recognizes and honors the relationship between Alaska and Canada. **YES**

5. **HB78 Government-employee Pensions** (Passed 21 to 19 on 5/12/2025). Makes major changes to the Public Employees' Retirement System and Teachers' Retirement System by reopening a defined-benefit pension option for certain public employees and teachers. **YES**

6. **SB96 Childcare Tax Incentives** (Passed 35 to 4 on 5/16/2025). Expands Alaska's education tax-credit system to cover certain employer payments and contributions for child care. **YES**
