1. Contains provisions for health care-related budget appropriations for FY 2023, including the expansion of Medicaid eligibility in Arizona. —

2. Requires the collection of DNA from a person that is arrested for any felony offense, rather than a person convicted of a felony offense or arrested for a specific felony offense. —

3. Applies to Congress "to call a convention for proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to set term limits for United States representatives and United States senators." —

4. Directs the Governor during a state of emergency to call the Legislature into a special session within 10 days to determine whether to terminate or modify the state of emergency. ✗

5. Specifies that early ballot affidavits must require a voter to provide voter information, including the voter's date of birth and an acceptable form of government-issued identification number. ✗

6. Uses the power of referendum to make students without lawful immigration status eligible for in-state tuition and financial aid at public colleges and universities in Arizona. ✗
