1. Reducing the Minimum Age to Purchase Firearms: Would reduce the minimum-age requirement to buy, sell, or transfer a firearm from 21 to 18. ✗

2. State-employee \"Fertility Preservation Services\": Provides State Group Insurance Program coverage for "standard fertility preservation services." ✗

Estimated Cost per household: **-\$0.09/year.**

3. Constitutional Money: Establishes "gold and silver coin as legal tender." ✓

Constitutional: **Yes** · Cast: **Yes** · HB999 · Passed 113–0 · 04/30/2025

4. Prohibiting UN-backed Climate Intervention: Prohibits geoengineering and weather-modification activities in Florida. ✗

Constitutional: **Yes** · Cast: **No** · SB56 · Passed 82–28 · 04/30/2025

5. Restricting Initiative Petitions: Prevents non-U.S. citizens and non-Florida residents from registering as petition circulators, directs supervisors of elections to notify voters whose signatures are verified, and forbids the use of public funds to advocate for or against any issue. ✗

6. Dental Student Loan Repayment Program: Allows certain dental and dental-hygiene students to apply for the Dental Student Loan Repayment Program before obtaining active employment. ✗
