1. SB4 Punishing Illegal Aliens (passed 25 to 11 on 2/13/2025). Creates criminal penalties for illegal aliens in Florida who entered the United States by “eluding or avoiding examination or inspection by immigration officers.” **YES** ★

2. SB700 Ban on Fluoride in Public Water (passed 27 to 9 on 4/16/2025). Bans the use of any additive to a public water supply that is not for the explicit purpose of improving water quality. **YES** ★

3. HB677 State-employee "Fertility Preservation" Coverage (passed 32 to 4 on 4/24/2025). Provides State Group Insurance Program coverage for “standard fertility preservation services.” **YES** ✗
Estimated cost per household: -\$0.09/year.

4. SB1804 Death Penalty for Child-sex Traffickers (passed 27 to 11 on 4/28/2025). Makes it a capital felony to subject a child younger than 12 years of age to human trafficking for sexual exploitation. **YES** ★

5. HB1205 Restricting Initiative Petitions (passed 28 to 9 on 5/2/2025). Prevents non-U.S. citizens and non-Florida residents from registering as petition circulators, directs supervisors of elections to notify voters whose signatures are verified, and forbids the use of public funds to advocate for or against any issue. **YES** ★

6. SB2514 Dental Student Loan Repayment Program (passed 34 to 0 on 6/16/2025). Allows certain dental and dental-hygiene students to apply for the Dental Student Loan Repayment Program before obtaining active employment. **YES** ✗
