1. State Sovereignty: Forces the state to give up some of its sovereignty and comply with a federal program and all of its subsequent amendments. ✗

2. Mask Mandate Ban: Prohibits local governments, health officers or the state from mandating face coverings. ✗

3. Gun Rights: Allows a group of people to assemble with firearms or parade in public with firearms. ✓

Constitutional: **Yes** · Cast: **Yes** · H0475 · Passed 57–13 · 02/23/2022

4. Emergency Order Termination: Terminated the long lasting COVID-19 emergency order implemented by the governor on March 13, 2020, which violated the law by extending the order for longer than 30 days. ✗

Constitutional: **Yes** · Cast: **No** · HCR040 · Passed 42–25 · 03/07/2022

5. Prohibit Reassignment Surgery on Minors: Prohibits doctors from performing sex reassignment surgery on minors and from distributing puberty blockers to minors. ✓

Constitutional: **Yes** · Cast: **Yes** · H0675 · Passed 55–13 · 03/08/2022

6. Voter ID: Strengthens the list of required documents to register to vote, to prove applicants' identity, address, and citizenship. ✗

Constitutional: **Yes** · Cast: **No** · H0761 · Passed 47–21 · 03/14/2022
