1. Revoking Driver's Licenses of Illegal Aliens: Provides that the Department of Transportation "shall revoke or cancel" the driver's license of a person who "is not lawfully present in the United States."
Constitutional: **Yes** · Cast: **No** · S1216 · Passed 26–9 · 02/01/2024

2. "Morning-After" Pill Requirement: Requires health benefit plans to cover a six-month supply of prescription contraceptives.
Constitutional: **No** · Cast: **Yes** · S1234 · Passed 19–16 · 02/08/2024

3. Defend the Guard Act: Establishes the "Defend the Guard Act," which prohibits the Idaho National Guard from being mobilized for active duty combat unless Congress has passed an official declaration of war or taken another official constitutional action.
Constitutional: **Yes** · Cast: **Yes** · S1252 · Passed 27–8 · 03/04/2024

4. Expanding Medicaid for Postpartum Services: Expands Medicaid to offer up to 12 months of postpartum coverage.
Constitutional: **No** · Cast: **Yes** · H633 · Passed 24–10 · 03/19/2024

5. Protecting Cryptocurrency: Would protect cryptocurrency by preventing state and local government from imposing undue or discriminatory regulations against blockchain and other forms of distributed ledger technology.
Constitutional: **Yes** · Cast: **No** · S1296 · Rejected 17–18 · 04/02/2024

6. Identification by Biological Sex: Provides a legal definition for "gender" that is consistent with a person's "biological sex."
Constitutional: **Yes** · Cast: **No** · H421 · Passed 26–8 · 04/02/2024
