1. Moscow Treaty: Would require both the United States and Russia to reduce their respective nuclear stockpiles to between 1,700 and 2,200 warheads by 2012. **✗**

2. Roe v. Wade Support: Declares that the Supreme Court decision in Roe v. Wade secures an "important constitutional right" and "should not be overturned." **✓**

3. Data Mining: Would require each federal agency or department engaged in data mining to submit a public report to Congress. **✗**

4. Prescription Drug Benefit: Would create a prescription drug benefit for Medicare recipients. **✗**

Estimated Cost per household: **-\$3,543.00/year.**

5. Assault Weapons Ban: Would provide for a 10-year reauthorization of the so-called assault weapons ban. **✗**

Constitutional: **No** · Cast: **Yes** · S.Amdt. 2637 to S. 1805 · 03/02/2004

6. Fiscal 2005 Budget Resolution: Would establish broad spending and revenue targets over the next five years, for a total budget of \$2.4 trillion. **✗**

Estimated Cost per household: **-\$21,429.00/year.**
