1. Motion-picture Tax Credit: Simplifies the program by replacing multiple fixed credit tiers with a single discretionary tax credit of up to 40%, to be awarded according to new LED program rules approved by legislative committees. **✗**

Estimated Cost per household: **-\$68.00/year.**

2. Restricting Speed-camera Enforcement: Limits the use of automated speed cameras, red-light cameras, and mobile speed cameras to school zones only, and requires clear signage and roadway markings to warn drivers. **✓**

Constitutional: **Yes** · Cast: **Yes** · SB99 · Passed 73–22 · 05/28/2025

3. Weather-modification Ban: Bans the intentional release of substances into the atmosphere to modify weather, temperature, climate, or sunlight, with exceptions for firefighting, agriculture, and forestry activities below 1,000 feet. **✓**

Constitutional: **Yes** · Cast: **Yes** · SB46 · Passed 58–33 · 05/29/2025

4. Ivermectin: Allows pharmacists to dispense ivermectin to adults under a standing order from a licensed healthcare professional authorized by the Department of Health. **✓**

Constitutional: **Yes** · Cast: **Yes** · SB19 · Passed 67–26 · 06/03/2025

5. Frog Gigging and Firearm Freedom: Removes the current ban on carrying or possessing a firearm while gigging and gigging frogs at night. **✓**

Constitutional: **Yes** · Cast: **Yes** · SB106 · Passed 93–0 · 06/03/2025

6. State Sovereignty: Strengthens the attorney general's authority to defend Louisiana's sovereignty under the 10th Amendment. **✓**

Constitutional: **Yes** · Cast: **Yes** · HB64 · Passed 77–22 · 06/09/2025



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
