| 1. Creates a refundable income tax credit for investments in Minor League Baseball facilities to keep teams in the state.

| 2. Imposes new rules on the development of renewable energy transmission in northern Maine.

| 4. Prohibits unauthorized paramilitary training in Maine. It makes it a crime (Class D) to intentionally train others in using weapons or combat techniques if the trainer knows it will be used for "civil disorder."
