1. Creates the "Maine Speedy Trial Act," setting strict deadlines for when criminal trials must begin after arraignment, with shorter timelines phased in over several years depending on the severity of the charge. ✗

2. Proposes adding an "Equality of Rights" amendment to the Maine Constitution. ✓
