1. Creates new restrictions on firearms lacking serial numbers, and bans "undetectable firearms" in Maine. ✗

2. Updates the state's renewable and clean-energy laws by setting a 2040 goal that 90 percent of retail electricity sales come from renewable resources and 10 percent from "clean resources," including certain nuclear, hydro, and low-emission generators. ✗

6. Declares that if Congress does not propose a constitutional amendment by December 31, 2026 to regulate money in politics, then Maine will formally apply for an Article V convention. ✓
