1. Speedy Trials: Creates the "Maine Speedy Trial Act," setting strict deadlines for when criminal trials must begin after arraignment, with shorter timelines phased in over several years depending on the severity of the charge. ✗

2. Equal Rights Amendment: Proposes adding an "Equality of Rights" amendment to the Maine Constitution. ✓
Estimated Cost per household: **-\$0.55/year.**

3. Abortion-drug-prescriber Protection: Amends prescription-drug labeling rules to allow the prescriber's name to be removed specifically for mifepristone, misoprostol, and their generic equivalents. ✓

4. MaineCare Funding: Enacts an emergency measure that immediately provides a one-time allocation of \$117.6 million to fund MaineCare for fiscal year 2024-25. ✓
Estimated Cost per household: **-\$191.00/year.**

5. Defend the Guard: Prohibits Maine's National Guard from being sent into active-duty combat overseas unless Congress issues a formal declaration of war. ✗

Constitutional: **No** · Cast: **Yes** · LD265 · Passed 109–33 · 04/24/2025

6. Status of Women Commission: Requires the Permanent Commission on the Status of Women to study how much gender segregation exists in Maine's workforce. ✓

Constitutional: **No** · Cast: **No** · LD522 · Passed 82–63 · 04/15/2025
