2. SB34 Woke Discrimination Protections (Passed 22 to 14 on 4/17/2025). Broadens the definition of "sex" to explicitly include pregnancy, childbirth, lactation, and related medical conditions, ensuring these are protected under anti-discrimination law.				NO ★
3. SB134 Consumer Protection (Passed 19 to 18 on 6/10/2025). Expands the state's ability to investigate and penalize deceptive or fraudulent business practices.				NO ★
4. SB224 Bump-stock Ban (Passed 22 to 14 on 6/25/2025). Prohibits the manufacture, sale, transfer, or possession of bump stocks and multiburst trigger activators.				NO ★
5. SB396 Carbon Sequestration (Passed 29 to 7 on 9/4/2025). Regulates carbon capture and sequestration (CCS) in Michigan.			-\$0.04	NO ★
6. SB166 Education Funding (Passed 31 to 5 on 10/3/2025). Sets the 2025-2026 school-aid budget, appropriating about \$22.3 billion for K-12 public education.			-\$5,222.00	YES ✗
