MT Legislative Scorecard 2023

1. Would propose to amend Montana's Constitution by declaring that it is the "right of any person to keep and bear arms" and removing the restrictive clause regarding the carrying of concealed weapons. **✓**

2. Prohibits a ranked-choice voting method from being used to determine the election or nomination of a candidate to a local, state, or federal office. **✗**

Pro-Freedom: **Yes** · Cast: **No** · HB598 · 04/05/2023

3. Resolves that "the belief that the court has exclusive authority to interpret the constitution and that its decisions are binding on the other two branches is a myth based on a faulty understanding" of the U.S. Supreme Court's opinion in Marbury v. Madison. **✗**

Pro-Freedom: **Yes** · Cast: **No** · SJ15 · 03/02/2023

4. Would have, prior to being amended by the House, adopted a new definition of "electronic money" in the Uniform Commercial Code. **✗**

Pro-Freedom: **No** · Cast: **Yes** · SB370 · 03/02/2023

5. Would apply to Congress for a "convention of the states" under Article V of the U.S. Constitution. **✗**

Pro-Freedom: **No** · Cast: **Yes** · SJ2 · 02/01/2023

6. Clarifies that the right of individual privacy, as referenced in the Constitution or laws of Montana, "does not create, and may not be construed as creating or recognizing, a right to abortion or to governmental funding of abortion." **✗**

Pro-Freedom: **Yes** · Cast: **No** · SB154 · 01/26/2023
