1. Red-Flag Law Prevention: Would have prevented state or local agencies from implementing or enforcing "red flag" gun-control laws, and it would have prevented them from accepting federal money to enforce those laws.

2. Firearm Merchant Codes: Prohibits financial entities' use of merchant codes to track firearm and ammunition-related purchases.

3. Sound Money: Changes North Dakota's definition of money to ban free-market-based cryptocurrencies and pave the way for a government-issued Central Bank Digital Currency (CBDC).

4. Ranked-Choice Voting Ban: Prohibits ranked-choice voting in North Dakota.



Constitutional: **Yes** · Cast: **Yes** · HB1273 · Passed 71–17 · 04/10/2023

5. Drones & Autonomous Vehicle Grants: Provides appropriations to the department of career and technical education and agriculture commissioner for uncrewed aircraft system, autonomous vehicle, or other autonomous technology (drone) grants.

6. Mandatory Dyslexia Screening: Creates a dyslexia and literacy task force, reading instruction competency for teacher licensure, and the dyslexia screening and intervention program.
