1. SB13 Invalidating Illegal-alien Drivers Licenses (Passed 15 to 8 on 1/30/2025). Makes certain out-of-state driver's licenses invalid in New Hampshire if those licenses were issued specifically to illegal aliens.			YES ★
2. SB295 Education Freedom Accounts (Passed 16 to 8 on 3/27/2025). Expands eligibility for the state's Education Freedom Account program by removing the household-income cap.			YES ✗
3. SB287 Voter ID (Passed 16 to 8 on 3/27/2025). Requires certain absentee-ballot applicants to provide proof of identity with their application.			YES ★
4. HB557 School Budget Transparency (Passed 15 to 8 on 5/15/2025). Requires school budget ballots to include additional information for voters, such as the proposed budget's estimated tax impact and other school-district performance or cost data.			YES ★
5. HB649 Vehicle Inspections (Rereferred 19 to 3 on 5/15/2025). Would remove New Hampshire's requirement for annual passenger-vehicle safety inspections and on-board diagnostic emissions tests. <i>Estimated benefit per household: +\$6.14/year.</i>			YES ✗
6. HB377 Prohibit Puberty Blockers for Minors (Passed 16 to 8 on 6/26/2025). Prohibits doctors from providing puberty blockers or hormone treatments to minors.			YES ★
