1. Background Checks: Authorizes the FBI to conduct all National Instant Criminal Background Check System (NICS) searches concerning the purchase, sale, and transfer of firearms through Federal Firearm Licensees operating in New Hampshire. **✗**

2. Federal Vaccine Mandate: Prohibits state enforcement of any federal law, order, or rule that requires an individual, as a condition of employment or any other activity, to provide proof of vaccination against COVID-19. **✓**

3. Budget: Authorizes the state budget, which reduced state spending by \$172 million over the prior state budget. **✓**

4. Right to Work: Would make New Hampshire a Right to Work state, prohibiting collective bargaining agreements that require employees to join a labor union. **✓**
