1. SB6 Cloud-seeding Program Funding (Passed 39 to 3 on 6/2/2025). Appropriates \$600,000 in both FY 2025-26 and FY 2026-27 to the Desert Research Institute to support Nevada's State Cloud Seeding Program. Estimated cost per household: -\$1.01/year.			YES ✗
2. SB132 Clean Energy Fund (Passed 36 to 6 on 6/2/2025). Appropriates \$500,000 from the State General Fund to the Nevada Clean Energy Fund. Estimated cost per household: -\$0.42/year.			YES ✗
3. SB155 Illegals in Law Enforcement (Passed 27 to 15 on 5/22/2025). Allows Nevada agencies to hire noncitizens as law-enforcement officers.			NO ★
4. AB245 Second Amendment Violation (Passed 27 to 15 on 4/22/2025). Significantly tightens Nevada's firearm restrictions for young adults and older minors.			YES ✗
5. AB244 Styrofoam Ban (Passed 36 to 6 on 4/17/2025). Phases in a statewide ban on polystyrene foam ("Styrofoam") food containers.			YES ✗
6. AB82 Unamerican Holidays (Passed 33 to 9 on 4/17/2025). Requires the governor of Nevada to issue annual proclamations recognizing four cultural and religious observances: Diwali Day, Eid al-Fitr Day, Vaisakhi Day, and Vesak (Buddha) Day.			YES ✗
