- 3. "Human Rights" Housing:** Amends New York's Executive Law to officially include the "disparate impact" standard in the state's Human Rights Law related to housing.

- 4. Minority Business Contracts:** Requires every state agency in New York that awards contracts to create a three-year growth plan aimed at increasing the participation of minority- and women-owned business enterprises (MWBES) in contracts and subcontracts.

- 5. Assisted Suicide:** Would allow a mentally competent adult with a terminal illness and a doctor's prognosis of six months or less to request and self-administer medication to peacefully end his or her life.

- 6. Warrant Requirement:** Mandates that government agents must obtain a search warrant before accessing electronic device data—whether searching devices physically or accessing communications electronically.
