1. Increasing "Red Light Cameras" in New York City: Permits New York City to install "traffic-control signal photo violation-monitoring devices" at up to 650 intersections by 2027. ✗

2. Tracking Firearm Purchases: Requires financial institutions to use merchant category codes to identify firearm retailers. ✗

3. LGBTQ+ Advisory Board: Would have established the "LGBTQ+ advisory board" to make recommendations and assist with developing potential legislation and regulatory changes in New York state. ✗

4. "Climate Change" Reparations for Businesses: Creates the "climate change adaptation cost recovery program," which, among other provisions, demands payment from companies that have produced a certain amount of "greenhouse gas emissions." ✗

5. Repealing the Crime of Adultery: Repeals the section of state penal law relating to the crime of adultery. ✗

Constitutional: **No** · Cast: **Yes** · A4714 · 04/03/2024

6. Expediting the "Morning-After" Pill: Amends state law to allow pharmacists to dispense "self-administered hormonal contraceptives" over the counter 10 months earlier than previously slated to take effect. ✗
