2025 OH Legislative Scorecard

1. Bans DEI programs and offices, prohibits faculty strikes, bars institutions from taking positions on controversial issues, and requires a civics course for students. ✓

2. Alters age and schooling certificate requirements and extends allowable work hours for minors under 16-particularly allowing 14- and 15-year-olds to work until 9 p.m. during the school year. ✓

3. Prohibits any general or primary from using ranked-choice voting. ✓

4. Would have authorized a new license-plate design supporting the Ohio chapter of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP). ✗

Constitutional: **No** · Cast: **Yes** · SB85 · Passed 32–0 · 06/18/2025

5. Would amend state law to specify that people who are unlawfully present in the United States "are not privileged from arrest." —

Constitutional: **Yes** · Cast: None · SB172 · Passed 23–8 · 06/18/2025

6. Limits how much revenue local governments and school districts can raise from "inside millage" property taxes without voter approval. ✓

Estimated benefit per household: **+\$127.00/year.**

Constitutional: **Yes** · Cast: **Yes** · HB335 · Passed 23–10 · 11/19/2025
