1. NATO: To reaffirm the U.S. commitment to NATO.

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2. Planned Parenthood: To prohibit federal funding of Planned Parenthood.

3. Appropriations for Defense, Labor-HHS-Education, and Continuing Appropriations: Would provide \$855.1 billion in discretionary funding for fiscal 2019.

Estimated Cost per household: **-\$10,403.00/year.**

4. FAA Reauthorization and Supplemental Disaster Appropriations: Reauthorizes appropriations for the FAA and TSA, as well as \$1.7 billion for Hurricane Florence disaster relief.

Estimated Cost per household: **-\$13,168.00/year.**

5. Short-Term Health Insurance Plans: Would nullify the rule from the Departments of Treasury, Labor, and HHS that would expand the duration of short-term health insurance plans.

6. Yemen: To advance Senate Joint Res. 54, which would remove U.S. Armed Forces from "hostilities" in Yemen that have "not been authorized by Congress."
