2. **HB4473 State Budget (Passed 33 to 10 on 5/20/2022).** Creates an Inflation Relief Stimulus Fund in the state budget and would appropriate temporary rebates to taxpayers. **YES** ✗

3. **SB615 Bathroom Bill (Passed 38 to 7 on 5/19/2022).** Requires individuals to use restrooms or changing areas based on their sex. **YES** ★

4. **HB1775 Critical Race Theory Ban (Passed 38 to 9 on 4/29/2021).** Prohibits the teaching of Critical Race Theory and certain race based concepts. **NONE** ?
