1. UN Arms Trade Treaty: Sen. Inhofe offered an amendment to "uphold Second Amendment rights and prevent the United States from entering into the United Nations Arms Trade Treaty."

2. "Assault Weapons" Ban: Sen. Feinstein offered an amendment that would ban the future manufacture, import, sale, transfer, or possession of certain semi-automatic firearms.

3. Continuing Resolution: Continues funding government operations, including ObamaCare.

4. Ukraine Aid: Provides \$150 million for direct aid to Ukraine. Estimated Cost per household: **-\$1.22/year.**

5. Gas Tax: Transfers local transportation infrastructure projects to the states.

6. Executive Action on Immigration: Senator Cruz raised a constitutional point of order that the bill violates the Constitution's separation of powers because the bill would fund President Obama's executive action on amnesty.
