2. **HB4083 Green State Investments (Passed 34 to 21 on 3/6/2024).** Mandates that the State Treasurer and the Oregon Investment Council divest the state's Public Employees Retirement Fund from thermal coal companies. **YES** ✗

3. **HB4098 Childcare Program (Passed 46 to 9 on 3/6/2024).** Establishes the CHIPS Child Care Fund, a government fund, to support childcare funding. **-\$3.00** **NO** ★

4. **SB1533 Election Languages (Passed 45 to 9 on 3/6/2024).** Expands election language support by increasing translated voter pamphlets from five to ten languages. **-\$0.20** **NO** ★
